The Family Information Service (FIS) is the central place to find information on a wide range of children and family services across Lincolnshire, from childcare and leisure activities to financial benefits and support groups, to working with children. The FIS works closely with Children's Centres and extended schools to offer information directly to communities at local sites.

We have information on Ofsted-registered childcarers such as childminders, pre-schools, day nurseries and out of school clubs, as well as some useful unregistered provision such as parent and toddler groups and extended school activities.
