Dear parents/carers,

Welcome to a new school year and class structure! We are starting the year with the topic “Rocks, Relics and Rumbles” which is Science and Geography based.

During the course of this term I will be sending out weekly homework. This will be the week’s spellings, an activity based on these spellings and Maths each week and a single larger optional piece of topic homework which will be due the end of term – chosen from a list sent out. This Maths will be online from the website [Mathletics](#) (a separate letter is included for instructions of how to use the website.)

Weekly homework will be set every Monday and completed by the following Monday. This allows for the weekly spelling test on a Monday and a maximum practice time.

As they are in KS2 there is now an expectation that your children write their own comments in their reading records (a bookmark is in their reading record to help with the content of these comments). I will expect a minimum of 3 comments week, which will have to be completed at break time if not done. There will be some opportunity to do this in class.

Our PE day will be Friday (we will do Forest school next term).  
Because of the risk from COVID we would like your children to come to school that day in their PE kit. This means that all children will need jogging bottoms or track suit bottoms as the weather is getting colder. Also, they need to wear their school sweatshirt.
