

## Communication and Language

- We will continue to develop the use of social phrases, sharing and taking turns.
- We will use a range of stories to develop children's story telling and vocabulary linked to our topic.
- We will develop our vocabulary linked to a range of different celebrations by discussing Bonfire night, Diwali, and Christmas.

## Physical Development

Children will:

- develop their fine motor skills using dough disco and finger gym activities
- develop their pencil grip to support them with their writing.

In PE children will:

- develop their movement with a focus on jumping and moving in a range of different ways to help them develop their core strength.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Our PHSE topic is Celebrating difference.
- We will develop our understanding of turn-taking, sharing and considering the feelings of others.
- The Zones of Regulation - learning how to recognise and express simple emotions.
