Physical Development

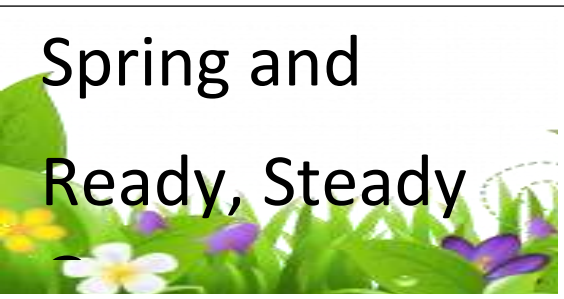
