Dear Parents/Carers

RE: TRIP TO CADBURY WORLD BIRMINGHAM – FRIDAY 30TH SEPTEMBER

On the 30TH September, Foxes class will be visiting Cadbury World. The trip has been organised to support the current Class topic “Scrumdiddlyumptious”. The class will have a tour of the facilities, learn about where chocolate comes from and take part in a workshop.

The children will be leaving school at 8:45 am, travelling to Cadbury World by coach; returning to school at approximately 5:00 pm for collection.

We need to cover the cost of travel and the activities, we are therefore asking for a **voluntary contribution of £20.00** per child for the trip. Cheques should be made payable to Lincolnshire County Council and be sent into school by Friday 23rd September 2016. Voluntary contributions are important because as a school we are unable to financially support all trips. If we do not receive enough contributions towards the trip we may not be able to organise events in the future.

All children will need a packed lunch and drink, please ensure you do **NOT** order a hot meal through Farm Kitchen. If you are eligible for free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided by school for your child. The children will need to carry their own lunch and we suggest using a small rucksack, if possible. Children need to wear school uniform on the day and comfy shoes or trainers.

There may be time to visit the gift shop at the end of the day. If children would like to bring a small amount of money, we suggest no more than £5, please ensure it is in a named purse or wallet.

Attached is a parental consent form for the trip. This form must be completed and returned to school by 23rd September 2016, if we do not receive the form back your child will not be able to go on the trip.
